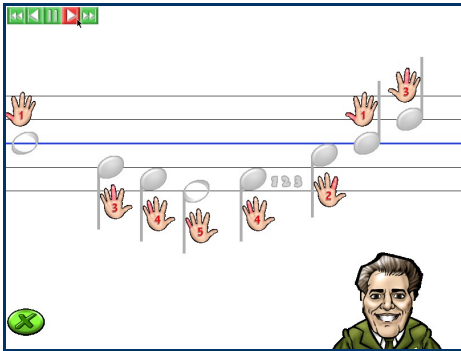




Lesson 24
